On April 1, 2015, after 14 years his predecessor Gerhard Kürner (44) will leave voestalpine of his own accord to work as an independent entrepreneur. The communications expert began his career with the Group in 2001 as Group Content Manager. After completing jobs internationally, Kürner was appointed Head of Corporate Communications in 2006. "Gerhard Kürner has done excellent work on behalf of the voestalpine Group and has helped shape its positive development in spite of difficult times. We thank him for his huge commitment and wish him all the best for his future success," said Wolfgang Eder.
